INSPECTOR'S TRAINING PROFILE INITIAL AND REFRESHER TRAINING PROGRAMME GUIDE

In accordance with the NCAA training policy documented in the FSG TGM Chapter 11 Inspector Training System, the airworthiness inspector must be trained in the training category Indoctrination, Certification, Surveillance, Personnel Licensing, Investigation, and given training on Management and Job Skills categories as functions demand. The training categories the initial and recurrent training that airworthiness inspector must be given throughout the career. As airworthiness inspectors progress in their career, they develop and achieve a wider spectrum of the competencies that needed to be maintained. The DAWS PPM requires airworthiness inspectors to be scheduled for a minimum of one refresher training course every year and when an inspector holds licenses on a number of aircraft, he should be scheduled for refresher/recurrent training on different types each year wherever possible.

The Training Coordinator has the responsibility of preparing training programmes for each year as part of each year's strategic plans in accordance with the NCAA corporate objectives and also to liaise with appropriate training institutions accordingly. This guide is to provide guidance to the training coordinator and the training committee set up by the DAWS in preparing yearly training plan for all category of inspector. The inspector training profile is maintained in soft copy for easy update or appropriate software. The frequency of refresher training should be 36months except where circumstances require lesser or greater frequency. A refresher training is not required to be a full course training but could be a module or two modules of the initial training. For example: Investigation under SMS could be a refresher for aircraft accident/incident training course.
